Location—Capel y Boro, 90 Southwark Bridge Road, SE1 0EX

Travelling by Tube and National Rail - The chapel is about 10 minutes walk from London Bridge Rail Station (Northern Line, Jubilee Line and main lines from Charring Cross, Cannon Street, the South and Thameslink). Borough tube station on the Northern Line is five minutes walk away.

By Car—Most parking restrictions last till 6.30pm

By Bicycle—Bikes can be left in the basement but must be secured by the owner

Disabled Access—Unfortunately there are steps to both the chapel and the hall.
